Subject: European Beach Handball Tour 2017/18 (ebt 2018) –
National observers

Dear Handball friends,

The EHF Beach Handball commission (BC) has established the function ebt Observer which was necessary to secure fair play and neutrality in all ebt tournaments. Also this year we kindly ask ALL National Federations to announce 5 - 10 national observers who shall take over the function as ebt Observer.

You can either re-nominate the same national observer, add further national observers (max. 10) or replace them.

An ebt observer can be:

- EHF Beach Handball Commission members
- EHF Beach Handball delegates
- National observer nominated by the National Member Federation

Each National Member Federation is therefore kindly requested to nominate 5-10 persons (Name, e-mail, date of birth, mobile number and profession) who can take over the role as a National observer.

When re-nominating the National observer of last year please check e-mail and mobile number and provide us with the date of birth!

A National observer:

- Should have knowledge of Beach Handball.
- Must be a member of National Member Federation itself (not club representative or private person).
- Should be able to correspond in English (report to the EHF Office).
- Should have PC knowledge and be able to use the internet.
- Needs to be reliable and neutral.
- Should be ready to visit national ebt tournaments.
- Shall not be involved in the organisation of the respective tournament or participate as a referee or player.
- Shall be present from the first until the last day of the respective tournament.
- Shall be accommodated in a single room during the tournament offered and paid by the organiser.
- Shall know the ebt regulations!

The task of a National observer is to:

- Participate in an ebt tournament (upon invitation of the local organiser).
- Be informed on the tournament criteria
- Check the criteria at the venue
- Enter the final criteria and final ranking of the tournament within 3 days from the end of the tournament (by using the EHFfamily portal) at the latest.
- Take and save a sufficient number of pictures proving the realisation of the published criteria (to be saved until the end of the running season). The pictures might be requested by the EHF in case of need!
- Reports to the EHF in any disciplinary matter or violation of the ebt regulations.
- If a national observer fails to appear or fails to fulfil the above mentioned duties (in case of already confirmed nomination), he/she will be deleted from the ebt Observer list and cannot be nominated again.

EHF Beach Handball delegates will automatically be in the ebt Observer list. EHF Beach Handball referees have to be nominated by the National Federations as National Observers and are not allowed to act as referee when nominated as ebt Observer.

Please think wisely about 5-10 suitable persons in your federation, who are able and willing to fulfil this task and return the questionnaire / corrected or confirmed list enclosed by 1 October 2017 at the latest.
