Seminar for new EHF Delegates in May 2019

Dear handball friends

The European Handball Federation accepted new EHF Delegates in December 2016 for the last time and is therefore planning to hold a Seminar for new EHF Delegates again at the end of the current season in order to have a group of new Delegates ready for the start of the 2019/20 season.

A seminar for candidates for the position of EHF Delegate will therefore be held from Saturday, 25 May to Monday 27 May 2019 in Balatonboglar/HUN with an arrival on Saturday afternoon and a departure on Monday afternoon. The venue of the seminar is the National Academy of Handball on the south shores of Lake Balaton.

The registration for candidates will be offered on line with a form that needs to be filled in and sent to the EHF by each person who is interested to register for the position of an EHF delegate. The registration is not limited to a certain group of persons and the present information is sent to all EHF Member Federations as well as to all those persons that expressed their respective interest in the last period of time. We therefore kindly ask all National Federations to spread these documents among the parties concerned within the Federation without any delay and make the respective information available accordingly.

The on line registration form will ask for standard personal data as well as information regarding the handball career of the applicant including his/her involvement in clubs and federations. Different to last time, it is not necessary to upload a personal video as this part of the registration procedure is replaced with an online person-to-person interview with each registered applicant.

Furthermore please remember the age limit for new delegates which is 55 years, therefore an application is only possible for persons who are born on 1 July 1964 or later.

Since there is already a good number of active delegates the EHF will only accept a maximum of around ten to fifteen new delegates during this registration procedure. It is therefore important for all applicants to also be prepared that their application might be rejected.

The on line registration will be open as of this weekend and will close on Monday, 15 April 2019.

Right after this period of the on line registration and after the online person-to-person interview we will inform all registered candidates whether or not they are confirmed as candidates and invited to the seminar in Balatonboglar at the end of May. The seminar will consist of an educational part with various information being offered including the evaluation of a referee performance at a live handball game, but will also have a testing part where the candidates will have to prove a certain amount of knowledge and ability in view to their tasks and duties as an EHF Delegate.

Additional information as well as details regarding the technical handling of the registration are attached to this e-mail in a separate document. Most important information and facts regarding the registration as a Candidate for the position of EHF-Delegate

Who can register to become a candidate for the position of EHF-delegate?

Basically any person. Of course, a certain relation to the duties and requirements of an EHF- delegate are needed and a history in handball is an important basic. A good knowledge of English is an absolute “must have” requirement and an application will have good chances to be rejected if the applicant does not have a good knowledge of English language.

Is there an age limit for applicants?

Yes, the age limit for new Delegates is 55 years and an application is therefore only possible for persons born on 1 July 1964 or later.

When is the on line registration open?

From Monday, 1 April 2019 to Monday 15 April 2019.

What is needed for a completed registration?

Only to fill in the registration form. An upload of a video is not necessary as each applicant will be contacted for a person-to-person online interview in English language after the registration is completed.

When does the EHF inform about the acceptance or rejection of the candidature?

In the period of time after 15 April 2019 until 23 April 2019.

When and where does the seminar take place?

The seminar will take place from Saturday to Monday, 25 to 27 May 2019 in Balatonboglar/HUN. Local transportation will be provided from Budapest Airport to the seminar venue (not individually, but in small groups coordinated with the arrival times).

How is the cost situation of the seminar?

Applicants organize and pay the travel to and from the seminar location themselves (except local transport from Budapest airport). EHF pays all costs for board and lodging during the seminar.

How many applicants will be accepted?

Approximately 10 to 15 applicants will be accepted for the seminar.
